



Ready Golf Guidelines

All groups are expected to play 18 holes in 4 hours or less and 9 holes in 2 hours or less!

ON THE TEE

- Shorter players should hit first. If not:
- First player who is ready should hit.
- Tee-off as soon as the group ahead is clear.

ONE THE FAIRWAY

- Take appropriate clubs to your ball and HIT WITHOUT DELAY.
- HIT WHEN READY: Do not wait for honors.
- Watch your ball. Mark it with an object if it leaves the fairway.
- Drop off your cart passenger, then drive to your ball.
- Players on opposite sides may hit simultaneously.
- Limit search for lost balls to 3 minutes.
- Pick up and place ball on green upon reaching your maximum WSGA-ESC score, then putt out.

ON THE GREEN

- Park your cart on the path in the most efficient spot to allow a quick exit from the green.
- Each group should LEAVE the green immediately after holing out and proceed to the next tee.
- Place your clubs between the green and the next tee.
- Study your putt while others are putting.

ALWAYS

- KEEP PACE with the group ahead.
- Keep practice swings to a MINIMUM.
- BE READY to play when it is your turn.
- Stay within ONE SHOT of the group ahead.
- MARK SCORES AFTER you leave the green (while others are teeing off).
- REMEMBER, if each player in a foursome saves only 5 seconds per shot, each round of golf would be shortened by 15 minutes.
